

RESULTS OF THE 100 EDITION OF THE TASTEVINAGE

The I00th edition of the TASTEVINAGE took place on Friday the 29th of September at the Château du Clos de Vougeot under the chairmanship of Jeannie CHO LEE, Master of Wine. A Jury of 228 (the capacity in litres of a traditional Burgundy pièce or wine-cask) selected the best Burgundy has to offer.

Of the 417 wines that underwent the rigorous selection process, 139 were successful.

THE LAUREATES OF THE 100th EDITION

A grand total of 228 judges – winegrowers, brokers, restaurateurs, wine-waiters, representatives of cooperatives, chairmen of growers' associations, distribution chain managers, journalists – chosen from an elite of connoisseurs and discriminating palates gathered in the Grand Cellar for the blind tasting.

The list of wines submitted covered everything from Chablis to the crus of Beaujolais, from regional appellations to the most famous Grand Crus, and included still wines as well as sparkling crémants.

The narrow percentage of winners is proof of the strictness of the selection criteria.

Out of the 417 burgundies tasted, only 139 were judged to be worthy of the TASTEVINAGE label – in other words, 33.33% of all the wines submitted.

The new labelling will soon appear on bottles of tasteviné wine, allowing consumers to identify quickly and efficiently the tasteviné appellation.
