On Friday 17 November in the Palais des Congrès in Beaune, the organization awarded seven Trophies to young winemakers.

The seven 2017 trophy winners, all aged under 40 or else running their own establishment for less than five years, are:

- Arnaud LAVANTUREUX, du Domaine Roland LAVANTUREUX à Lignorelles, pour le Trophée Chablisien
- François GALEYRAND, du Domaine GALEYRAND à Gevrey Chambertin, pour la Côte de Nuits
- Laurent GAY, du Domaine Michel GAY & Fils à Chorey-les-Beaune, pour la Côte de Beaune
- Erell et Flavien NINOT, du Domaine NINOT à Rully, pour la Côte Chalonnaise
- Xavier GREUZARD, du Château de la GREFFIERE à la Roche-Vineuse, pour le Trophée Mâconnais
- Mee GODARD, du Domaine Mee Godard à Villié-Morgon, pour le Trophée Beaujolais

A jury of 120 wine industry professionals selected this year's winners from 72 participants, during the 29th edition of the Young Talents Trophies. Each candidate presented three different appellations from their estate from the 2015 vintage.

The award ceremony, hosted by Claude Nadeau, took place under the patronage of Mrs Sophia Zaïme, aka Madame Wine, high-end wine specialist, specialized in coaching and personalized advice, and Mr Bill Nanson, writer and journalist (Burgundy-report.com).

The GJPV was created in 1959 to bring together young winemakers and help promote their skills. It has some 130 members, of all ages and all trades, across the whole of the greater Bourgogne area.
