AT THE 2021 WINE TOURISM AWARDS

The judges at the 2021 *Terre de Vins* Wine Tourism Awards at Bordeaux's *Cité du Vin* have given their verdicts. The Chateau du Clos de Vougeot was among the prize winners at the third edition, receiving the *Grand Prix d'Or* in the 'business and private events' category.

Organized by the magazine Terre de Vins in partnership with the wine tourism section of the French tourism development agency Atout France, the third consecutive edition of France's wine tourism awards ceremony the Trophées de l'Oenotourisme - was held on June 3rd last at the Cité du Vin in Bordeaux.
